[PROPOSED] ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFF’S EX PARTE APPLICATION FOR A TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER AND/OR PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION AND ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Before the Court is Defendant Jammin Java Corp.’s (“**JJC**”) *Ex Parte* Application for Temporary Restraining Order and/or Preliminary Injunction (“**Motion**”).

The Court, having fully considered the Motion submitted by Plaintiff, as well as any documents, evidence, argument, and declarations, if any, in support thereof,

THE COURT FINDS THAT:

- (1) JJC has made a clear showing that it is likely to succeed on the merits at trial in this action,
- (2) JJC has shown that it is suffering, and will continue to suffer, immediate and irreparable harm if the requested relief is not granted,
- (3) The balance of the hardships weighs heavily in favor of JJC on the present application for a temporary restraining order, and
- (4) The requested relief is in the public interest.

1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT a Temporary Restraining Order shall
2 issue as follows:

3 Plaintiff 56 Hope Road Music Ltd. ("56HR") IS HEREBY ORDERED TO:
4 Immediately reinstate the license agreement between 56HR and JJC in
5 order to authorize JJC to utilize the licensed products until a final decision in
6 this matter.

7 PLAINTIFF 56HR IS FURTHER ORDERED TO SHOW CAUSE at
8 _____ on _____, 2016, or as soon thereafter as counsel may be heard
9 why 56HR, their officers, agents, servants, employees and attorneys should
10 not be restrained and enjoined from enforcing the purported termination of the
11 subject license pending trial of this action.

12 This Order to Show Cause and supporting papers must be served on
13 Plaintiffs no later than 7 days before the date set for hearing. Any response or
14 opposition to the Order to Show Cause must be filed and personally served on
15 Defendant's counsel no later than 3 court days before the date set for hearing.
